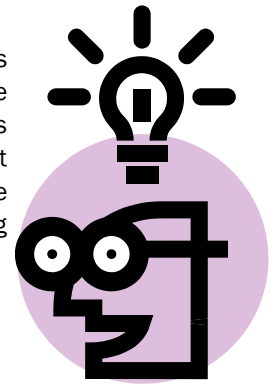

Charles – Getting to Know You – Resident

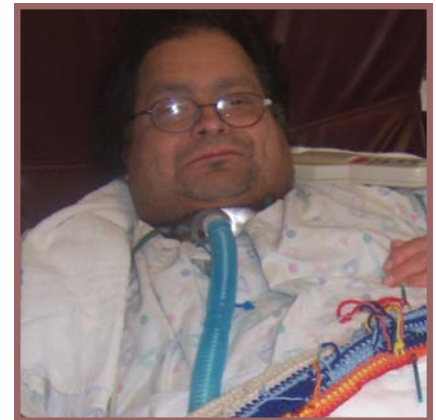
Charles is a proud member of the Chumash Native American tribe and has lived in Santa Barbara all of his life. He graduated from Santa Barbara High with a major in Political Science.
